## FATHER PAUL-DOMINIQUE MARCOVITS' SPIRITUAL LETTER

# *The Disciples of Emmaus:* 2/ *The Explanation of Scripture*

We left the two disciples in deep sadness, overwhelmed by disappointment: their master died on the cross. So they leave Jerusalem. And now a stranger joins them. They do not know that it is Jesus "because their eyes were prevented from recognising him": their eyes were too clouded with distress and their eyes of faith were not yet opened. But deep down, there were not just painful memories, there was certainly an expectation that had not yet been completely extinguished. The stranger, Jesus, will awaken it

For those of us who meditate on this extraordinary story, we always feel great emotion. The disciples ask all their questions and Jesus answers! So many questions inhabit our hearts! Jesus responds. He comments on the Scriptures, to them, to us, like a long liturgy of the Word: the crossing of the Red Sea, the passage from the land of slavery to the land of freedom, is already the passage from death to life, from darkness to light. It is Christ, the conqueror of death who draws us into his life!

And now Jesus, step by step, on this road to Emmaus, leads his disciples towards the truth of his life which saves all mankind. During this conversation, what happened in the hearts of the disciples? An awakening! The voice of the Master touches their ears which were accustomed to listening to the Lord. Probably also, a sense of freedom awakens in them: this stranger's attention, respect and compassion opens them up . But there is more. They had followed Jesus, they had heard his words so characteristic of God's love, of God's life! They had believed in him. **So, the awakening takes place within them, it is the awakening of faith, it is the awakening of their hope; life deep within them awakens!** Everything they had received from the Lord and also their total gift to the master comes back to life! Their hearts will soon be "burning within them?"!

Jesus awakens them, not only to what they have experienced, but above all he opens them up to the whole truth, "Jesus opened their intelligence to the understanding of the Scriptures: Christ had to suffer in order to enter into his glory." Intercessors, we constantly ask that those for whom we pray awaken to this mystery of life. For us, for them, the essential thing still remains to be discovered: it will be in the breaking of bread. In the meantime, let us rejoice in having a "burning heart"!

## INTERCESSION IN THE HISPANO-SOUTH AMERICA

We are Josefina and Miguel Alarcon and we have been part of Teams of Our Lady for 19 years. Recently, we were called to assume the service of Responsible Couple for Intercessors of the Hispano-South America Super Region, which covers the Argentina and Ecuador Regions, Paraguay, Peru, in addition to the Chile Sector and Teams in Uruguay.

There are 305 Intercessors in the Hispano-South America Super Region. We join up with them to pray together via WhatsApp, Rosaries on Zoom and emails.

Inspired by the reading of the Road to Emmaus, the Intercessors' mission is to be companions on the spiritual path, bearers of hope, mutually accompanying each other towards a deeper encounter with Jesus.

Just like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, many may feel discouraged, confused, or even distant from the divine presence in their lives... But the Lord is there, with us!

In Luke's Gospel 24:13-35, we are told that Jesus walks with the disciples, but they do not recognise him. Yet, along the whole the way, they talk, accompany him, intercede for him. This mystery reflects how, in our own lives, we sometimes fail to perceive the loving presence of Christ around us. However, by explaining the Scriptures and breaking bread, Jesus reveals his identity, opening eyes and hearts.

#### Let us open our hearts so that, on the road to Turin, the Lord accompanies us, enlightens us and transforms us.

Selfless prayer for our brothers and sisters is an act of charity. Father Caffarel tells us, "*Can we frequent the Fire without being burned, approach Love without burning with love for God and for mankind? Prayer and charity are linked.*" (Cahiers sur l'Oraison 143).

## **INTERCESSION IN THE COLOMBIA SUPER REGION**

Intercession in the Colombia Super Region is experienced day after day with great intensity and has increased thanks to the commitment of numerous intercessory couples from different regions and in their respective cities, who are responsible for encouraging and motivating interested people to pray for multiple needs. How do we experience this call to Intercession?

- 1. Coordinators of apostolates per region and animators of Teams in their respective cities.
- 2. Virtual groups via WhatsApp.
- 3. Prayer of the Holy Rosary in various modes: with a community, virtually and/or in person.
- 4. Monthly or bi-weekly Masses offered especially for Intercession.
- 5. Prayer vigils generally with the Blessed Sacrament exposed in constant adoration.
- 6. Speeches and lectures to provide and disseminate information on intercessory prayer.
- 7. Retreat organised by the intercessors semi-annually or annually.
- 8. Prayer of thanksgiving for the testimonies received.
- 9. Motivating Team members to be Intercessors and to attend the dedicated monthly Mass.
- 10. Prayer for the beatification of Father Caffarel.

Today, the apostolates in our Colombia Super Region are experienced with great sensitivity, intensity and commitment. The prayer intentions received are present in the lives of all Intercessors and in their prayer groups. We thank God for all those who encourage intercession in their cities. We are aware that as long as the Apostolate continues to be exercised with humility, commitment and always under the direction and company of our Intercessor, the Virgin Mary, everything will go well for the Glory of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
