Since Father Caffarel's Appeal in 1960, the Intercessors, in the same communion of prayer, have spread. This openness to the world, linked to that of the Teams of Our Lady, has gradually become more structured. A fundamental reflection was carried out for several years within the Intercessors' Animation Team. It led to the creation of an International Team for the Animation of Intercessors, the EIAI, in 2018, during the Gathering of the Team of Our Lady in Fatima, and to the celebration of the 60th anniversary of the Intercessors in 2020:

- Edition of a History of Intercessors.
- Creation of a new logo.
